Blank verse is poetry that has no set stanzas or line length It is a common form of poetry seen often in Shakespeare, Milton, Yeats, Auden, Stevens, and Frost In fact, a great deal of the greatest literature in English has been written in blank verse Blank verse is unrhymed lines that follow a strict rhythm, usually iambic pentameter
